

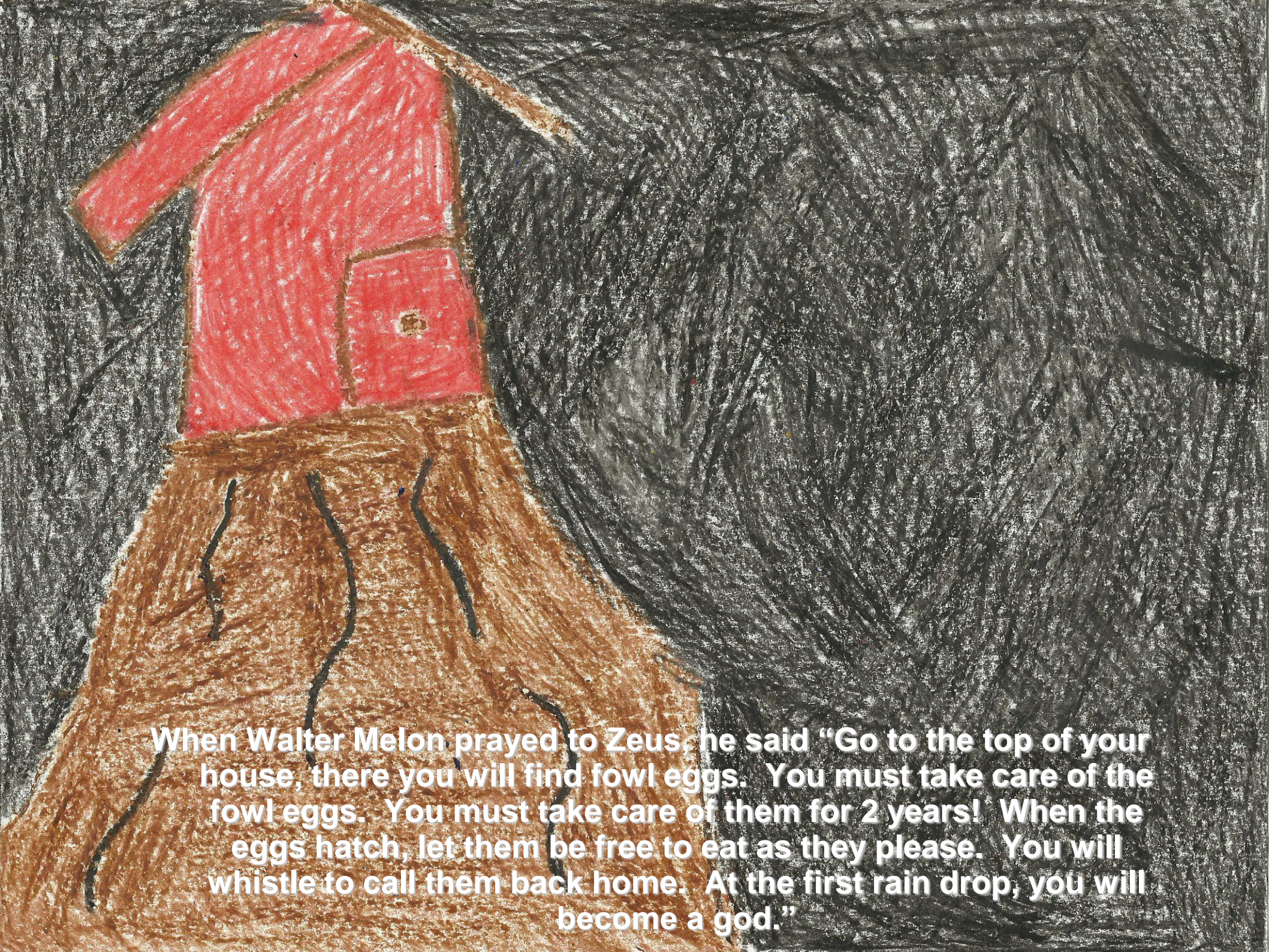
Walter Melon: the God of Rain

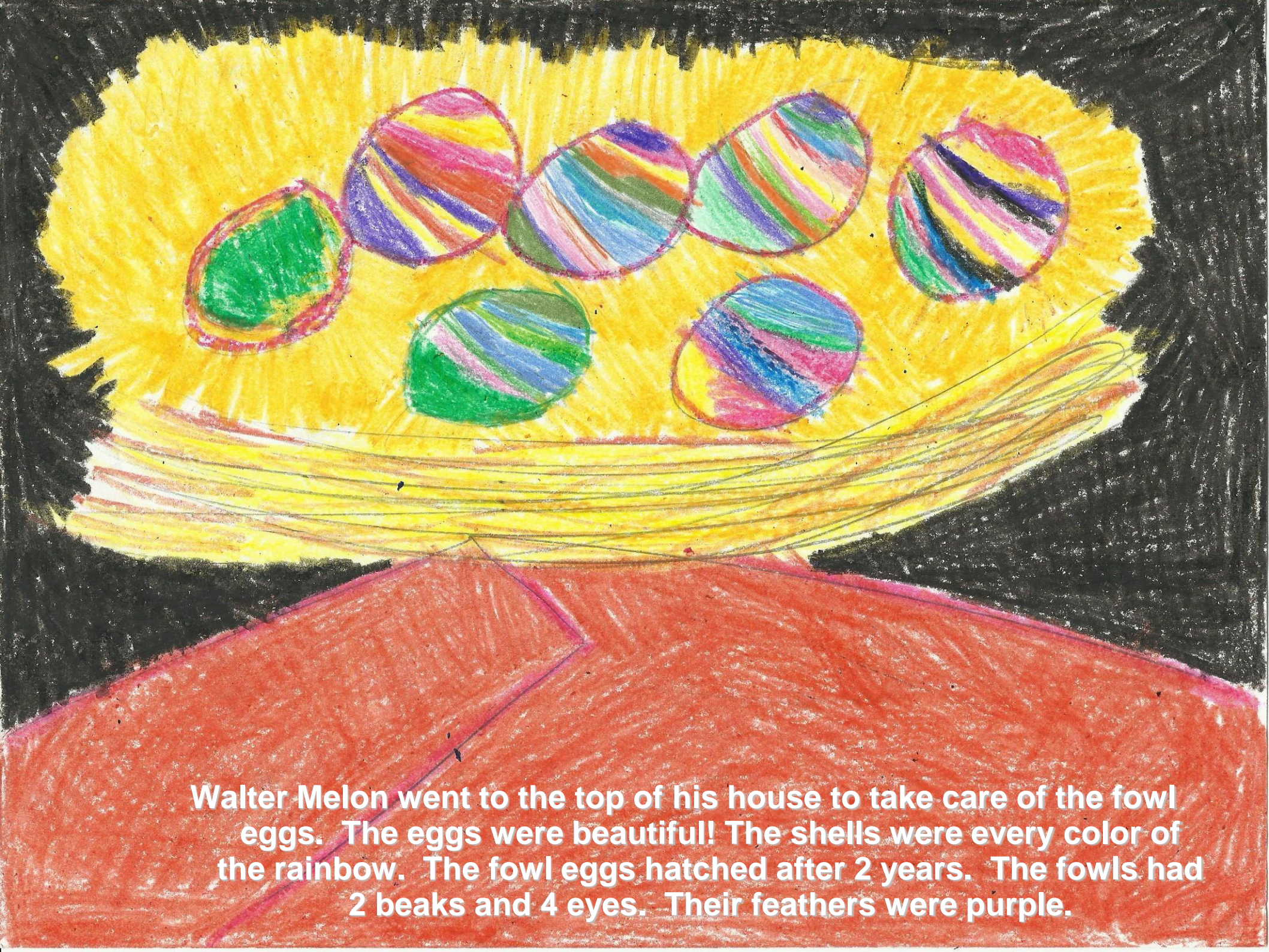

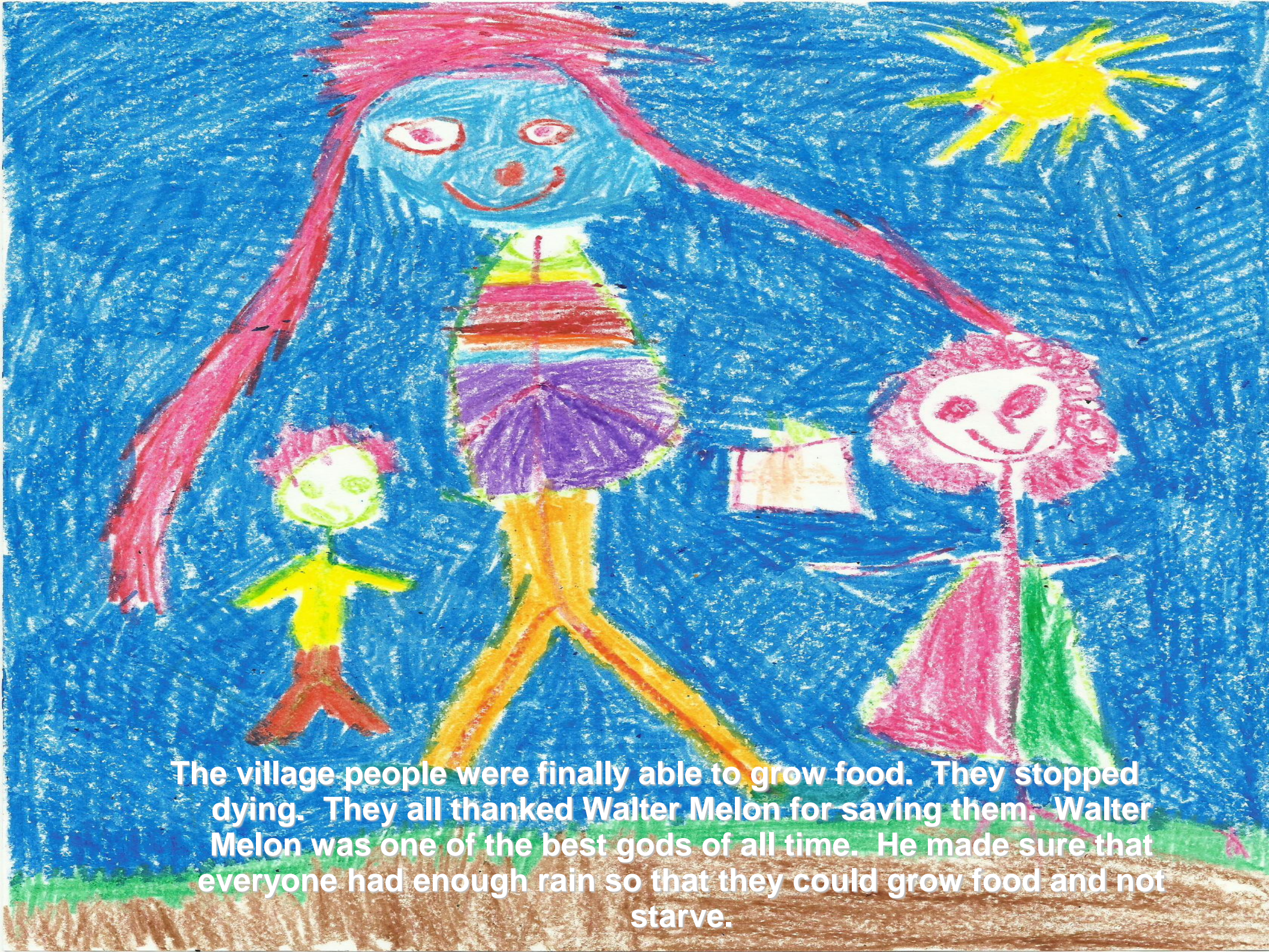
